board and their officers saw at a glance that if the flatboat was on fire the boats would all of them be burnt. So they put in their protest against her on fire, unless that she would be pulled out in the stream. The mob paid little attention to the officers, but they soon found, when they covered four or five of them with their rifles that they were in earnest. They swore they would shoot, and they would attempt to set her on fire she then was.

It was an attack in the rear, and a more than was bargained for, and they could not stand the fire of the negro in front and a few determined men in the rear, the mob concluded that discretion was the better part of valor, got a yawl, made a line fast to the flat boat, and commenced pulling her out into the stream, at the same time two men boarded her and set her on fire, at considerable risk, as the negro kept blazing away at them whenever a chance offered. When they got out about a hundred yards the negro cut the line that was towing him, and he went ashore. The boat was now all in a pile at one end, when the negro came on board the other, clapped his breast, and swore he was king of the black race, and would die like a man. The wind, however, drove the boat to the shore at the time, and the negro fled across the river, and the boat was saved. At this time the negro supposed to be a white, and himself when he was pulled out of the water with a section of a stove, appeared at the end of a line fast to it, making a dash to his neck, overboard he the other came up which was the last, and negro, and an end to the "Cairo of the day."

Cor. of the Baltimore Sun, Washington, Dec. 5 1854. *Editor of the Oxford Herald.* I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your issue of the 1st inst. containing an account of the proposed resolution in regard to the progress of Oxford, introduced by Mr. S. V. & P. M. POOL, and in which you referred to the committee on foreign relations. In the present state of European politics it is better not to insist on making private conversations public.

The veto on the river and harbor bill came next in order and was sustained, less than two-thirds—in fact more than one-half—the members present sustaining the bill, in spite of the President's objections. News from Europe is eagerly expected, and all sorts of rumors in regard to it are already circulating free gratis, for nothing.

We must all have patience. From the present tenor of the course it is not likely the tariff will be touched this session. It will be a fruitful theme to be discussed in the next Congress, and will probably occupy the whole of the next long session.

The President is rather down on the railroad schemes, and recommends a wise discrimination in regard to them. I do not believe that the number of railroad bills likely to pass this session will either squander the public domain or materially depress the stock market in Wall street. According to all appearances, the revenue from customs of the fiscal year terminating June 30th 1854, will not equal the revenue of the past year, and the surplus of revenue for 1855 will be considerably less than it now is.

A change in the naturalization laws had already been mooted by several members, anxious to take the law by the forelock. No such modification will pass the present Congress.

Col. Bissell was in the House on Monday last, and looked very much improved in health. He was warmly greeted by his friends.
